PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of the South Haven Area Water-Sewer Authority (the "Authority") intends to file an application for federal financial assistance with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, Rural Utilities Services. The project includes design, purchase, acquire, install and construct improvements to the Authority's Water System, including but not limited to improving water mains, replacing existing water mains and installing new water mains, and other water main work, elevated storage tank improvements, including without limitation the demolition of existing facilities and the construction of an elevated storage tank, booster station improvements, including without limitation the demolition of existing facilities and the construction of a new booster station, identification and replacement of service lines, including without limitation, the identification and replacement of lead, galvanized, and other water service lines throughout the Authority to comply with the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy's Lead and Copper Rules, the restoration of streets, sidewalks, rights-of-way, and easements affected by the improvements and related facilities, as well as all work and equipment necessary or incidental to these improvements, and such other Water Supply System improvements the Authority shall determine to make, if any.
